RAY CANDELENT MEMORIAL TROPHY

This Trophy is in memory of Ray, who had been associated with Rugby Police Bowls Club since 1971 until his untimely death in October 2018.

During this time, he was a mainstay of the club, having filled the roles of President, Match Secretary and Secretary throughout the majority of this time.

RULES OF PLAY

- 1. A Drawn Pairs Competition
- 2. Five games to be played consisting of four ends each, with a coin tossed for order of play before each game, with each player using four woods. (Number of ends played can be adjusted according to how many people take part)
- 3. In the event of a tied, killed or dead end, the end is **not** to be replayed With two shots awarded to the team **not** 'killing' the end.
- 4. Scoring: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie
- 5. The Winners will be the team with the most points
- 6. In the event of a tie it is the aggregate shot difference followed by the highest number of shots.
- 7. In the event of any disputes the Captains' decision is final.
